### New Jersey Business Immigration Coalition (NJBIC) Releases Set of Principles for Immigration Reform Einstein's Alley is a founding member of NJBIC



"The Coalition believes in the importance of building in flexibility in how annual admission numbers are determined so that numbers can rise and fall based on the needs of the economy."

A newly formed coalition of business groups committed to bipartisan immigration reform has weighed in on aspects of the Biden administration's immigration reform legislative package. Although the content of "The Citizenship Act of 2021" is currently available only in summary form (the full text of the bill is expected to be published in a matter of days), the Coalition, in a statement issued today, believes that the bill is a "constructive first step in the long delayed effort to achieve immigration reform."

According to Coalition Coordinator Nicholas Montalto, the Coalition consists of major business groups in the state, including the New Jersey State Chamber, the New Jersey BIA, regional and ethnic chambers of commerce. Members of the Coalition "view lawful immigration as a powerful tool for economic recovery and growth."

At this stage in the legislative process, the Coalition has chosen to comment on four broad aspects of the immigration policy challenge: overall numbers, admission categories, legalization, and the educational pipeline.



Mercer County Community College (MCCC) is in the process of applying for a \$4 Million NJ Securing Our Children's Future (SCF) Community College grant. The renovated warehouse, newly named the "Trenton Innovation Center", would house two main academic programs (Automotive - electric vehicles and Mechatronics) as well as offer a training facility in growing fields related to renewable energy and sustainability.


